RULES

1. New Mexico Farm & Livestock Bureau will award three recipients a \$1,000 scholarship to attend a university/community college/ trade or vocational school of their choice. Awardees' immediate family must be current members of NMF&LB.
2. Scholarships are limited to one per recipient per lifetime.
3. A transcript of high school record to date, college transcript, if already attending, documentation of your SAT/ACT scores, and two letters of recommendation must accompany this application.
4. Attach a copy of current Farm Bureau membership card.
5. Successful candidates must have at least a 2.5 scholastic grade point average based on a 4.0 scale.
6. A recent photograph **must be attached** and will be used for publicity purposes only.
7. Application must be type written or in legible print in ink.
8. Extra pages may be added if necessary.
9. No one will be disqualified because of sex, race, color, creed or religious beliefs.
10. Application must be received by April 1st at the office of the New Mexico Farm and Livestock Bureau, 2220 N Telshor Blvd, Las Cruces, NM 88011.
